To expedite review of your submission for probable cause, please use the following checklist to make sure the documents in your packet are in the format required by the above-referenced judge(s).

REMOTE WARRANTS:

- □ Use the remote warrant forms for the Application and Warrant. <u>E.g.</u>, AO 93C and 106A for typical warrants, AO 102 and 104 with remote signature language for tracking warrants
- □ Make sure agent's ink or digital signature is affixed to the affidavit and application.
- Use the signature language for remote signing under Rule 4.1 and 41(d)(3) or 4(d), as applicable, instead of the usual "Sworn to and subscribed before me . . ." for inperson oaths.
- □ Submit all documents as PDFs. Once the documents are signed by the judge, chambers staff will "flatten" the packet before emailing it to the agent and AUSA.
