Rules, the following rules apply to all criminal matters before the undersigned:

1. Motions to Vary or Depart from the Applicable Sentencing Guidelines.

Parties are to file any motions to vary or depart from the applicable Guidelines fourteen (14)

days prior to the sentencing hearing. This includes motions by either party made pursuant to §

5K.1.1 of the United States Sentencing Guidelines and/or 18 U.S.C. § 3553.

2. Sentencing Memoranda. Parties who intend to file sentencing memoranda

must do so at least seven (7) days prior to the sentencing hearing.
