
Dear Mr. Parkinson:

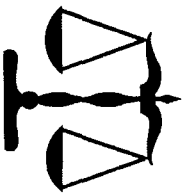
