PERSONAL NARRATIVE RESUME OF ROBERT A. SOWINSKI

Mr. Sowinski is a Certified Circuit Court Mediator and has successfully completed the forty hour Circuit Court Mediation Certification Training Program offered by the Continuing Legal Education Division of the South Carolina Bar Association in Columbia, South Carolina. Mr. Sowinski is a member of the Dispute Resolution Section of the South Carolina Bar Association.

Mr. Sowinski has been married to his wife, Vicki, for 43 years.
